Tori, you want to introduce our guest and have them present the project?

MS. RILEY: Yes. Cailean Mackay is with me this evening, and we are proposing a 44,500-square foot spec building, and Cailean would like to tell us a little bit about the project.

We are asking for a PILOT tax exemption, as well as sales tax exemption and mortgage tax exemption.

The total project cost is \$4,016,963, of which we are asking for property tax exemptions of \$441,243, an estimated value of sales tax exemptions of \$126,419, and estimated value of mortgage tax exemptions of \$27,090. The exemptions equal about 14.9 percent of the project total.

The spec spaces are very needed throughout Saratoga County, and without these incentives, it would be probably impossible.

MR. MACKAY: Impossible with rising interest rates and carrying costs and all that fun stuff.

CHAIRWOMAN HERRICK: Want to talk a

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# Proceedings - February 7, 2023 little bit about the scope of the project, like what are you going to put up in Luther Forest? MR. MACKAY: So it's two buildings totaling 44,500 square feet. Each building is roughly a little over 22,000 square feet. Each building will contain about 15 units, starting at 1,250 square feet and going up to about 1,500 square feet. They'll have 16-foot bays in them, 14-foot tall garage doors. You'll have the

ability to put a mezzanine in so you can have an
office above them.

So, small contractors looking for space, you can easily rent out the whole thing, put a mezzanine in for an office, have storage for materials below, and it's great for just about everybody, really.
